"Return to the Lord your God for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love." – Joel 2:13

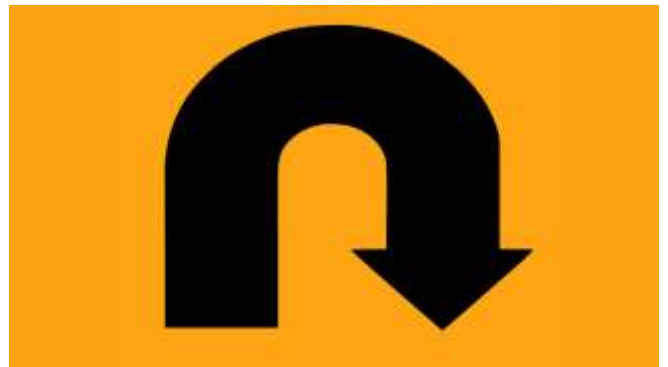

As Charles Spurgeon once said, 'Repentance is a discovery of the evil of sin, a mourning that we have committed it, a resolution to forsake it.'

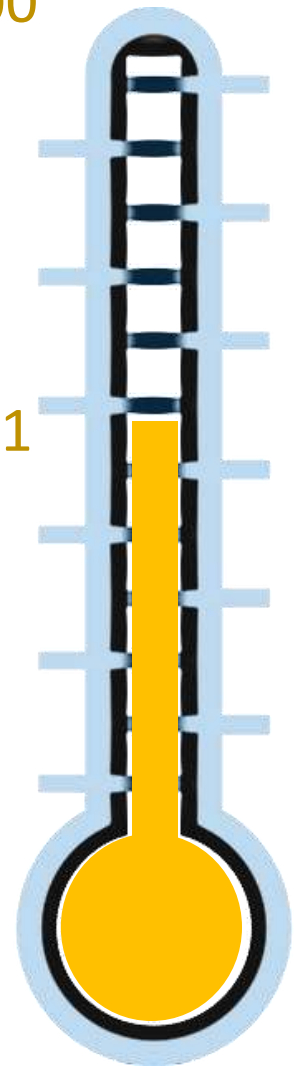
